Community Living Campbellford/Brighton Labour Dispute Resolved

The Board of Directors of Community Living Campbellford Brighton and Nancy Brown, Executive Director, are pleased to advise that the recent labour disruption was resolved April 23, 2017. We also wish to take this opportunity to extend sincere thanks and appreciation for the support received from the community during this time.

The key issue being the use of personal vehicles was resolved and both parties recognize that “employees may at times need to use their personal vehicles to transport people supported”. Employees will receive an increase towards the cost of insurance premiums and mileage expenses. The Organization currently maintains a fleet of 14 vehicles and have committed to increasing this to a total of 16 vehicles.

In addition, a wage increase of 0.45 cents per hour over the 2 year duration of the Collective Agreement ending March 31, 2018.

Established in 1960, Community Living Campbellford/Brighton provides support and services to approximately 140 people throughout Northumberland County and Area. Community Living Campbellford/Brighton fosters and encourages meaningful inclusion and participation for people with an intellectual disability.
