March 22, 2017

Community Living Campbellford/Brighton located at 65 Bridge Street, Campbellford, ON has received a notification from the Ontario Public Services Union Local 316 that effective March 22, 2017 at 12:01am all unionized employees will be on strike. There has been intense negotiations and mediation by both parties in advance of the strike notification. Nancy Brown, Executive Director stated that “Community Living Campbellford/Brighton presented what we believe is a fair, financially responsible and sustainable offer that addresses the key issues of our employees.”

Community Living Campbellford/Brighton supports people with intellectual disabilities and their families in a wide range of services including residential and employment supports, respite, supported independent living, community participation and resource centres. Nancy Brown, Executive Director of Community Living Campbellford/Brighton indicated that “the people we support are at the heart of who we are as an organization. Our priority is to ensure the safety and well-being of the people we support and their families. All essential services will be maintained during the labour disruption.”

People supported and their families, community partner organizations, funders and elected officials have been informed of the labour disruption. Regular updates will be posted on the website of the organization. The administrative office will operate on reduced hours during the strike.

John Mood, President of the Board of Directors of Community Living Campbellford/Brighton stated that the organization “remains open to meaningful dialogue to reach a sustainable and financially responsible collective agreement.” Community Living Campbellford/Brighton is directly funded by the Ontario Ministry of Community and Social Services and the Ontario Ministry of Children and Youth Services.
