Summer Employment Transitions strives to seek employment for local students with disabilities/barriers to employment who wish to gain summer work experience. Participants will receive the support of a job coach on the job.

Summary of Responsibilities & Required Qualifications:

- Age 16 to 29 years old
- Must have a disability or barrier to employment
- Must live within Northumberland County or surrounding area
- Must have a Social Insurance Number
- Must have own transportation to and from work
- Be available to commit to work the entire summer (7 weeks)
- Commit to work varying hours as required by the employer
- No vacation time may be scheduled for the duration of the SET program
